
ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO APPROVE LETTER TO OPT OUTS

The joint motion of Plaintiffs Lyndon Veterinary Clinic, PLLC, et al. (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) and Defendant Stericycle, Inc. (“Stericycle” and together with Plaintiffs, the “Parties”) for approval of a proposed letter to be sent to entities that have attempted to opt out on behalf of other members of the Class by signing one opt out request and attaching a list of other entities that are purportedly covered by that same proposed opt out (the “mass” opt outs) came before the Court. Having considered the motion, and good cause appearing therefor, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the motion is GRANTED.

The Court further orders that:

- (a) The letter attached to the Parties’ motion as Exhibit A is approved;
- (b) The Parties and the Class Action Settlement Administrator are directed to send that letter to the “mass” opt outs, identifying the deficiency and providing the member of the Class ten (10) days to correct the deficiency and submit a valid request for exclusion; and
- (c) Any members of the Class that do not timely correct any deficiencies be removed from the Opt Out List, be “bound by all proceedings, orders and judgments in the Litigation” and that they otherwise be deemed eligible to receive the benefits of the Settlement.
